



Carillion, has been selected as the contractor for Kent County Council's New Line Learning Academy and preferred bidder for the Kent Batched Academies programme, worth a total of £118 million. This exciting project delivered through Partnerships for Schools' National Academies Framework involves the design and construction delivery of 5 large secondary education facilities throughout the county of Kent.

The work is being managed from our West Malling office.

## About the project

The New Line Learning Academy is a £25m construction scheme. The 18 month project will involve the redevelopment of a new academy building with associated sports building and facilities, circulatory access roads, strategic landscaping works and car park facilities. Demolition works of the existing academy will take place on completion.

## Recent event

A bolt tightening ceremony was held on 20<sup>th</sup> April 09 to mark the erection of the structural steel frame.

Guy Hewett, the School's Principal, is seen here securing a major column to the foundation bolt sets, overseen by Gigi Luscombe, the Deputy Executive Principal and Alan Enfield, the Vice Principal.

This is just part of what will become a total of 1,000 tonnes of the structural steel frame.

## Works in progress

We have had a productive period, completing the raft foundations, drainage and sports hall slabs. This has allowed the commencement of the steel frame at the reception end of the building. The next period will see the commencement of the upper slabs, brickwork and roofing works.
