(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cave Hill and Hayle Mill Road, Tovil.

Closures are planned from 30th March 2020 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005KL1W00000061624AAP - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

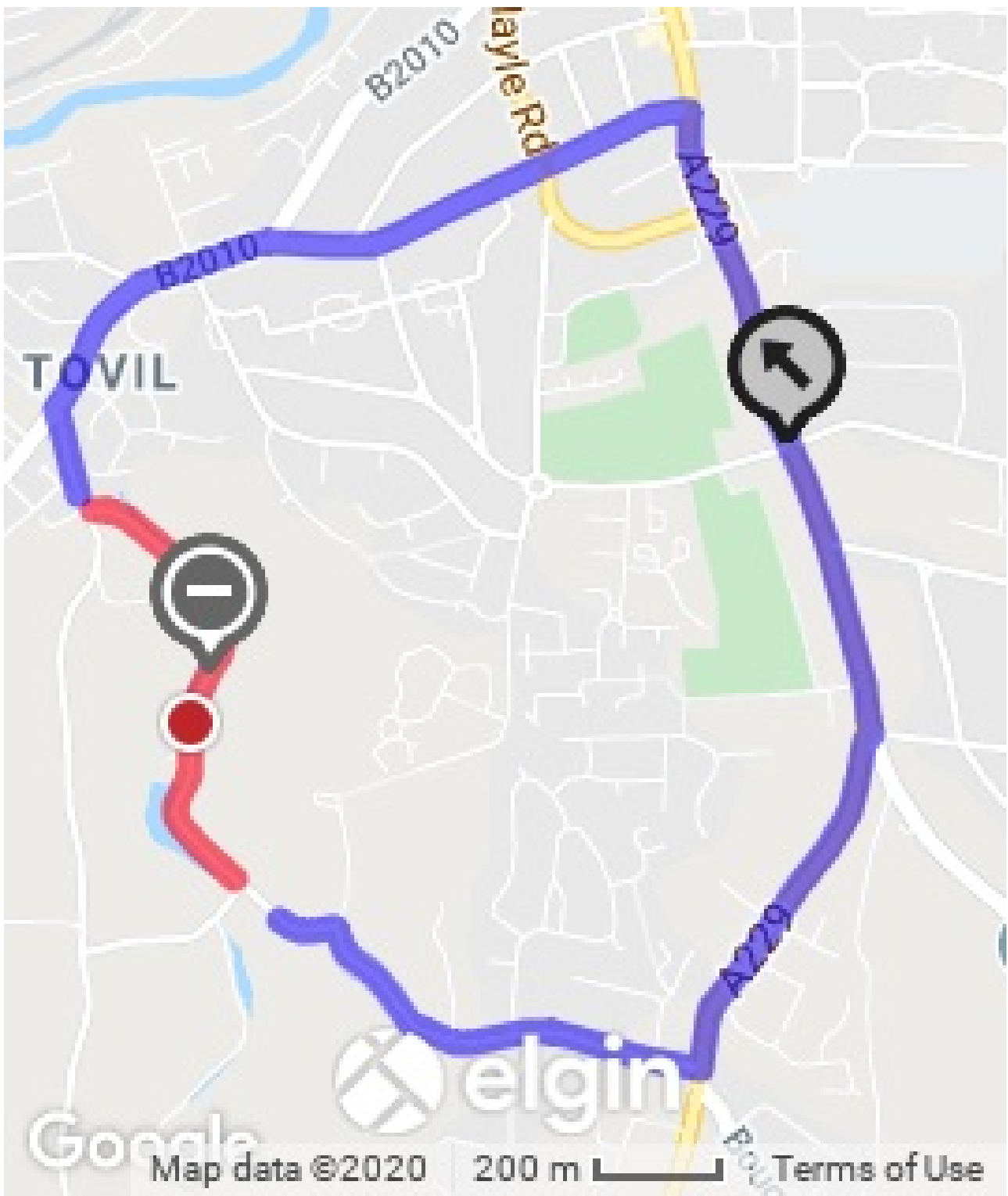
Cave Hill and Hayle Mill Road will be closed between the junctions with Straw Mill Hill and Bockingford Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Straw Mill Hill, B2010 Tovil Hill, Courtney Road, Armstrong Road, A229 Loose Road, Cripple Street, Teasucer Hill, Hayle Mill Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
